

GLOCK® Blue Label Sales Eligibility

As determined by the Attorney General of Massachusetts, Glock handguns lack a load indicator or magazine safety disconnect, in violation of the handgun regulations pursuant to 940 CMR 16.00. Therefore, handgun dealers may not sell newly manufactured Glock handguns to Massachusetts consumers. The handgun regulations do not pertain to firearms used by law enforcement or military personnel as part of their official duties. As such, we will only sell modern production (i.e. post 10/21/1998) Glock handguns to Massachusetts residents with the following credentials:

- Sworn Law Enforcement Officers (active or retired): to include local, county, state, and Federal, full-time, part-time, reserve, special police
- Deputy Sheriffs (active or retired)
- Military Police (active or retired)

Per our Blue Label Sub-Distributor agreement, we cannot ship any Blue Label Glocks to an FFL; they must be picked up here at Pioneer Valley Arms. You will be limited to two (2) Blue Label Glocks purchases per year, but we can special order Glocks at commercial pricing upon request.

Please note that other categories of law enforcement or military employees (to include corrections officers, etc.) will not qualify for Glock sales. If the purchaser is not one of the above categories, we would require an official request on law enforcement or military agency department letterhead naming the individual, asserting their status as active duty in good standing (retired will not qualify) and authorizing the purchase of the Glock handgun, signed by a chief or supervisor other than the purchaser. This may be submitted in person, or in an email sent from their official email address (personal emails will not be accepted).

These category requirements will also apply to the sale of any other handgun that does not meet the requirements under 940 CMR 16.00; in addition, the handgun still must appear on one of the Massachusetts approved firearm rosters. If the handgun does not appear on one of the approved firearm rosters, we cannot sell the handgun to any resident of Massachusetts, regardless of what credentials they possess.

Please note that a valid photo ID is required for the sale to proceed, along with a valid resident License to Carry and a state-issued driver's license or ID card. If the individual does not have a valid ID for any of the above categories, we will require either:

1. a copy of the individual's affidavit of being recently sworn into duty for one of the above categories, **or**
2. an official request on law enforcement or military agency department letterhead naming the individual, asserting their status as active duty in good standing (retired will not qualify) and authorizing the purchase of the Glock handgun, signed by a chief or supervisor other than the purchaser. This may be submitted in person, or in an email sent from their official email address (personal emails will not be accepted).

Pioneer Valley Arms is required by the Glock Blue Label program to retain a copy of the purchaser's department-issued photo I.D. If the purchaser is a Federal employee and cannot allow their I.D. to be duplicated, we will require a business card for our records instead.
